

# Full Bloom Quilt label templates



The templates are reversed for use with fusible applique. Cut label background fabric 8-1/2" x 9". Trace the template pieces to the paper side of the fusible web. Cut out shapes leaving 1/4" around each shape. Cut the center out of the fusible web leaving 1/4" around the inside of the shape. Place the fusible web pieces paper side up on the wrong side of each selected fabric, fuse following manufacturer's directions. Cut out pieces directly on traced lines. Trace the embroidery lines to your flower center with a light fine pencil line. Arrange pieces to the right side of the label block, overlapping pieces as shown. Press to fuse. Finish the edges as desired. Backstitch "full bloom" with 3 strands of DMC #469 green, your name, year and place with one strand #311 blue. Embroider the flower with a lazy daisy stitch and three strands of #3832 rose. Press under 1/4" along the top and inside edge of the label. Leave the label edges raw along the outside quilt corner edges. Handstitch the top and inside edges of the label to the quilt back with a blind stitch. Bind the quilt in your favorite method catching the outside edges of the label in the binding.
